Freedom On February 11, 1990, Mandela walked out of prison He received joyful welcomes wherever he went around the world In 1991 he assumed the presidency of the ANC, which had been given legal status again by the government Both Mandela and deKlerk realized that only a compromise between whites and blacks could prevent civil war in South
